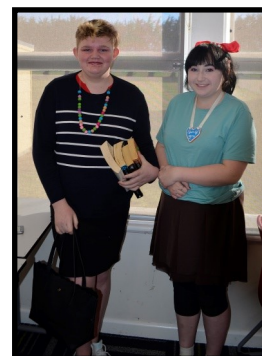

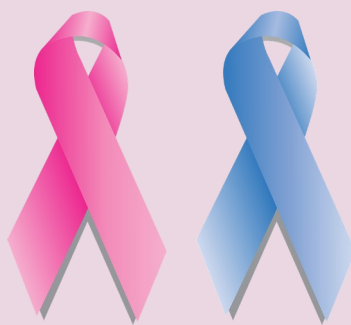
Please read the information for parents attached to enrolment forms as it provides the details of evidence required.

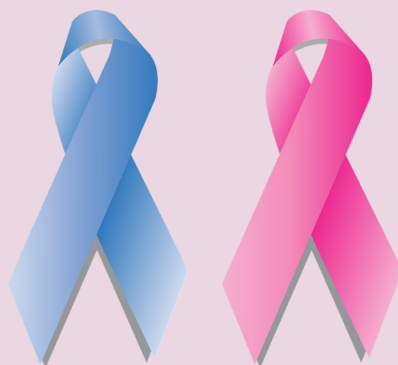


Dear Parent/Carer

For a while now, students at Bothwell have been able to put their soft plastic waste in separate bins ready for recycling. From the beginning of this year however, China has stopped taking Australia's recyclable plastics. Now there is far too much plastic for Australia to deal with. Students at Bothwell are asked to help and reduce the amount of plastic waste/ We create by 1% by the end of the year. Here is how it works, Over a week Primary Classes have sorted plastic waste from their lunch boxes into categories and created a tally sheet. Now the challenge is to **replace 1 item of packaged food** with something **not packaged**.

They will be asked to try this every 2 weeks. An example might be to take out a bag of tiny teddies and replace it with an unwrapped biscuit, or a muffin. Towards the end of the school year, students will sort out plastic waste from their lunchboxes again and see whether their tally has been reduced by 1%.

I am asking for your support with this by helping our students taking up the swap suggestion every two weeks, starting this fortnight.
