From the Principal...

Welcome back to school and to the last term of the year. Traditionally Term 4 is the busiest with end of year celebrations and Christmas being such a big focus.

Staff and students have started the year well. I would like to take this opportunity to remind teachers, students and parents of the goals we discussed during mid-year reporting. Now is an ideal time to reconsider these goals and what needs to be done to ensure they are achieved.

A number of students have come to me over the last couple of weeks of Term 3 and again this week sharing with me that they have a limited work opportunity, usually on nearby farms. This is a valuable opportunity for students but it does take away from their time at school. While regular school attendance helps students to gain greater skills and knowledge, work opportunities often broaden student outlook considerably and give students a real reason for attending school. Ultimately attendance at school versus a period of paid employment is a parent's decision. We completely understand that this could be a very positive opportunity, we ask that you keep us informed as much as possible.

I have been out of the school a couple of times this week. One of the meetings I attended was specifically focussed on the extension of our school to year II and I2 commencing with Year II in 2021. In the coming months and into next year we will be looking to discuss the possibilities around this with parents, employers and community members. I encourage any parent, regardless of the age of their children to start considering where their child will attend school for Years II & I2. Under the new Education Act it will be compulsory for students to follow an approved learning pathway such as Years II/I2 or an apprenticeship. I will be sharing early thoughts and considerations with our School Association, next Monday October 21. You are all most welcome to attend.

There has been lots of excitement and talk this week about our student experience opportunity tomorrow – The Mud Run. I would like to take this opportunity to wish all participations a great day.




Kinder\Prep

The students can continue to enjoy having some toast and a nice warm Milo at the start of the day on Mondays and Thursdays.


