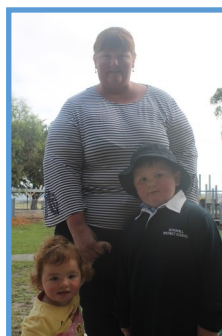

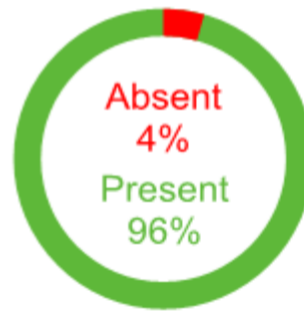
Unfortunately we weren't quick enough to take a photo of Miss Griggs.
