This year our focus is to get the school farm up and running. Since the start of the term to now we have been pulling down fences, marking where the hazelnuts trees are going, moving things, cutting down trees, and pulling down the sheep yards.

We have also been soil testing to see how good the soil is so that we know what the soil is going to be like when we plant the hazelnut trees.

This has been a good opportunity for students to get outside on the farm and have a go at doing these particular things. Mr O'Toole runs a 'Farm' option on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday for students.

People who are in his group go out on the farm and help out with things, like the list above. We have all worked together and achieved a lot on the farm already. Mr O'Toole always makes sure that we have got a job to do and that we understand that every little thing helps with what should be a great farm in the end!

We still have a lot ahead of us. We are all looking forward to seeing how it all turns out.


